The averages for our last tests were only two point apart yet he decided a 90-10 split was appropriate, but I disagree. In my opinion, this made it hard to prepare for the tests because if I focused more on preparing for the free-response I would do really well and a get a 90 on it but he would then decide it would only be worth 10% of the test grade, ultimately making me get a very low grade on the test.
